The PRCC Chaplain Ministries is responsible for credentialing, recruiting and commissioning our reformed Presbyterian Chaplains to serve Christ in many federal and civilian institutions such as the Army, Navy, Air Force, Marines, Coast Guard and many other institutions like VA Medical Centers, Bureau of Prisons, Hospitals, Hospice Care, College Campuses, Retirement Communities, Addiction Centers and Police and Fire Departments. The PRCC Chaplain Ministry is a growing ministry and our seven conservative and evangelical Reformed Presbyterian Denominations (listed below) are witnessing God's grace and favor as He expands this critical ministry.

The primary purpose of the Chaplain Sponsorship Program is to enlist prayer support for our Chaplains. Since they do not have the privilege of ministering to an established congregation, they are not supported in prayer to the degree that is needed. Therefore, we enlist sponsoring congregations, Women's Ministries, and presbyteries to support and remember in prayer the Chaplain, his ministry and family, and those he serves. The Chaplain commits to providing the church with periodic updates with specific prayer requests. Our goal is to enlist three sponsoring congregations for each Chaplain.

In addition to providing prayer support for our Chaplains, we request that sponsoring congregations include PRCC/MNA Chaplain Ministries in their annual budget. Although Chaplains receive their salaries and benefits from their employing institutions, they require the Ecclesiastical Endorsement, training, prayer support, and encouragement of their denomination. That requires support staff, travel, supplies, and the publishing of the *Guardian Prayer Calendar*.

This support is made possible through the gifts of individuals, churches, and presbyteries. We request that churches who support a Chaplain in prayer also consider supporting PRCC Chaplain Ministries financially as well. It takes about \$1,800 per year (\$150 per month) for us to support and care for your Sponsored Chaplain. Anything your church can give towards that amount will certainly be appreciated. Churches often treat their Sponsored Chaplains just like the other missionaries they support financially.

We keep our supporting churches and presbyteries informed of Chaplain Ministries through our periodic publication, *The Guardian Prayer Calendar*.
