



Christ Presbyterian Novi is about two miles from a redevelopment project in Northville that is adding over 400 homes to the area.

The church has roughly 40 aging members who need a pastor and who are eager to engage the mission of reaching their community however they can assist the Pastor/Planter in doing so. This Mission work also has significant financial means in place which includes ownership of a church building and a 1,600 square foot home.




Highlights

Located about 30 miles northwest of Detroit and northeast of Ann Arbor. A redevelopment project is transforming the Northville Downs horse racing track into a mixed-use community named "The Downs" with 443 residential units, retail space, & 15 acres of green space. More than 1,400 acres of parkland in Novi engages over 140,000 users annually. White collar workers make up 81% of the workforce.
