



### Age Demographics



**Auburn Hills** is located in southeast Michigan along the scenic Clinton River. According to census data, the city has seen a population increase of over 16% in the last ten years and growth is projected to continue. The city's website describes Auburn Hills as a "distinguished leader...with 40 international corporations from 32 countries, including many world and North American headquarters." With four colleges and one of the state's largest destination shopping centers, the city is hospitable to residents, workers, students, and visitors.



This growing population is primarily comprised of young, single, professionals. Unfortunately, more than 35% of the population identifies as non-Christian or having no religious preference. Given the statistics, Great Lakes Presbytery's vision is, with God's grace, to plant the first PCA church in expanding Auburn Hills.


