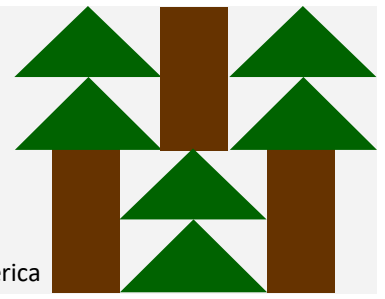

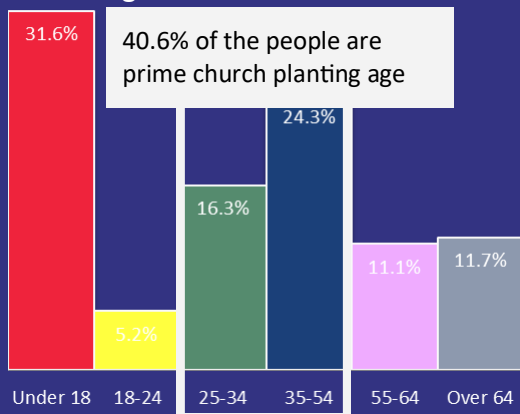

### Age Demographics

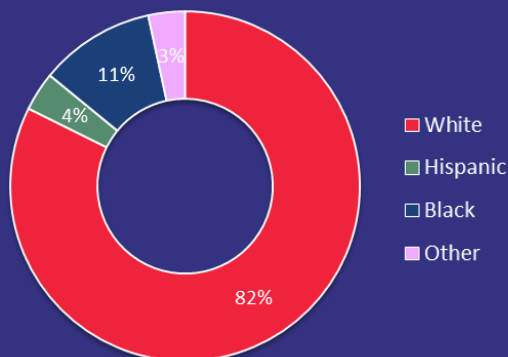

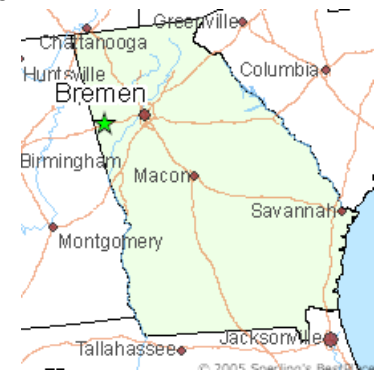

### Racial Demographics



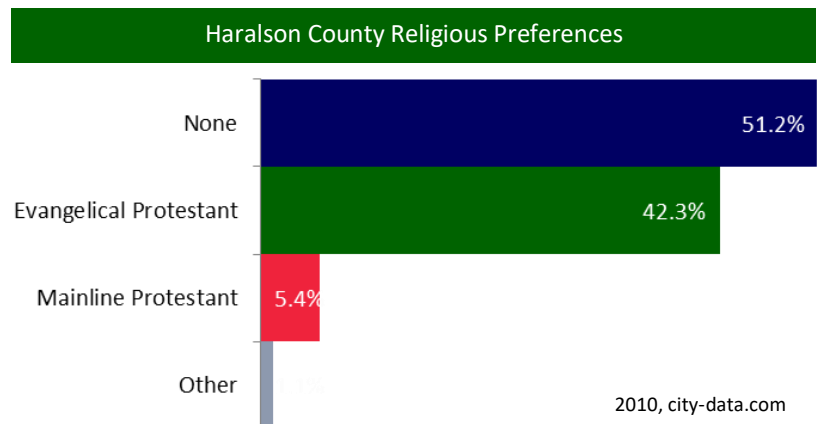
Bremen is a city in West Georgia located mostly in Haralson County, with a small portion in Carroll County.

"If there is a better community in the world, I don't know about it. Our goal is to continue to build and sustain a vibrant community that is committed to character, integrity, truth, honesty, respect, faithfulness, helpfulness, health and future stability. May God continue to bless our community and each one of you. Call us if you need us. Know that you are loved." states Mayor Sharon Sewell in her January 2019 letter sent out with the monthly water bill.



There are about 15,000 people in a five-mile radius of Bremen and more than 50% of the people in the area have specified "none" as their religious preference. The leadership of King's Chapel PCA in Carrollton, about 30 minutes from Bremen, is committed to planting a reformed church in their midst that will help the mayor move toward her goal by spreading the good news of the gospel throughout Bremen and beyond.

Working together with other PCA churches in the area, our hope is to begin a church planting residency program that will aid the growth of the Kingdom in Georgia.

## Bremen Highlights

About 45 miles west of Atlanta.

Bremen School District received an "A" rating for 2019.

Participant in the Southern Quilt Trail.

Home of the Mill Town Music Hall, a 1,040 seat concert venue, the largest in West Georgia.

Historical note: Bremen's economy was given a significant boost when the Chattanooga, Rome and Columbus Railroad was built, intersecting the Georgia Pacific at Bremen.

The Bremen Towne Festival is an annual event held on the third Saturday in October each year.

The Sports Complex offers a senior center, activity center, batting cages, a playground, and six ball fields.

Rock Park is a 10-acre park within two miles of every city resident.

In 2019 the Discovery Channel TV Show, Garage Rehab, featured their renovation of Bremen's unique local garage, American Warrior Garage. Richard Rawlings showed up to rehab this nonprofit garage that trains military veterans for careers in auto repair.

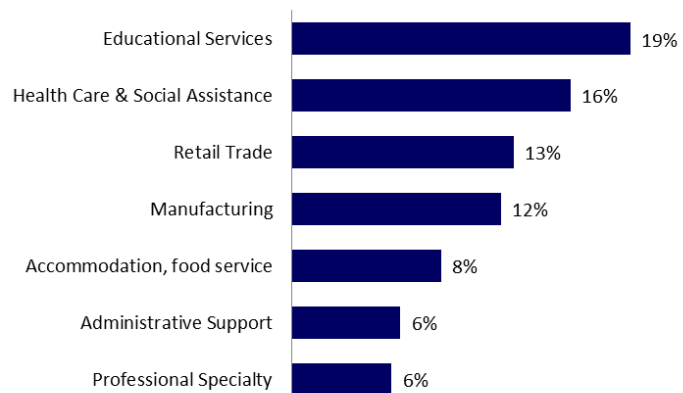
