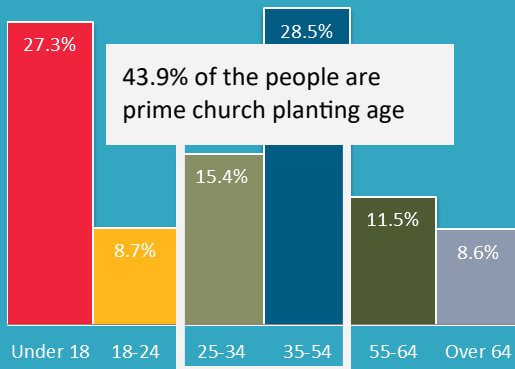

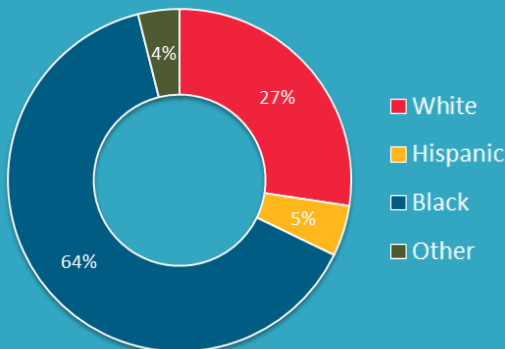

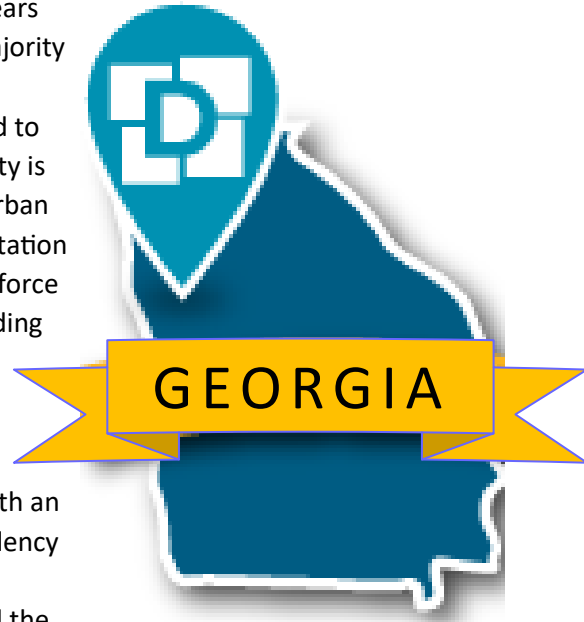

#### Racial Demographics

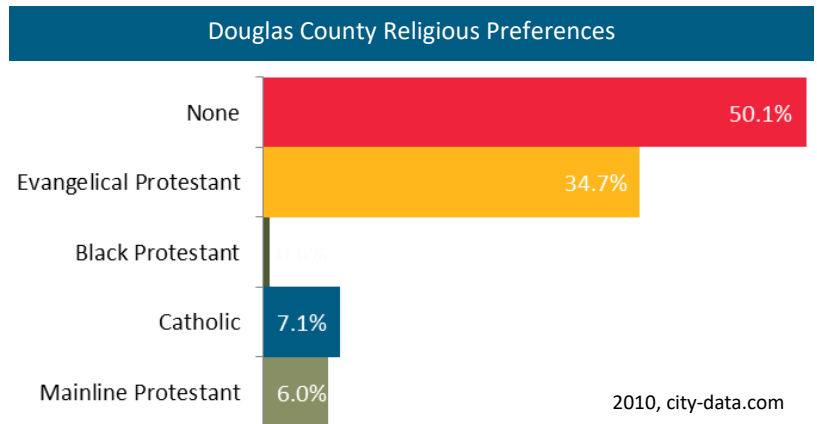


Douglasville is the county seat of Douglas County, Georgia and is part of the Atlanta Metro Area. Douglasville has been described as “a welcoming city with a friendly, small-town atmosphere and entertainment that emulates big-town fun.” Over the last 10 years Douglasville has become a majority -minority community. While population growth is expected to continue through 2040, the city is working to preserve its suburban feel while improving transportation and developing a skilled workforce to match available jobs according to its 2018 Comprehensive Plan.



King's Chapel Presbyterian Church in Carrollton, along with an emerging church planter residency program in the NW Georgia Presbytery, sees the need and the opportunity to plant a majority-minority PCA church in Douglasville. The hope is that God will use the church plant to reach the unchurched and de-churched among the growing Black American population.
