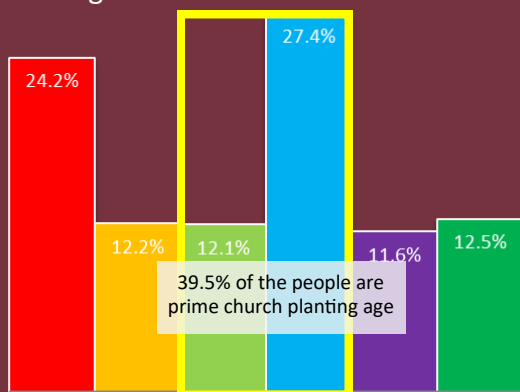

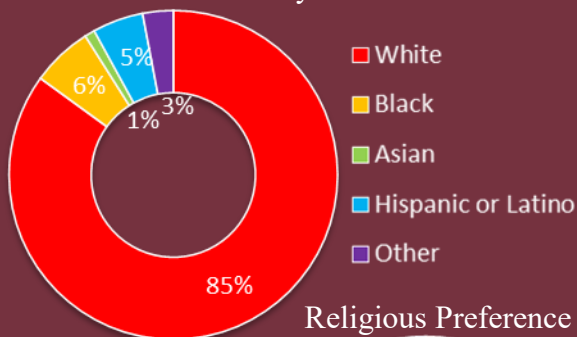

Age Demographics

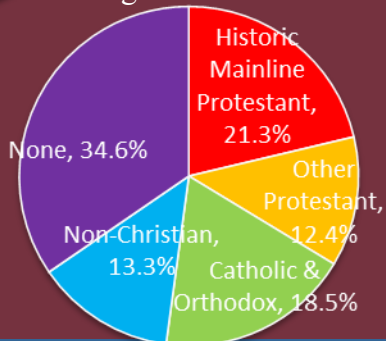

The Presbytery intends, by God's grace, to expand the reach of the gospel by planting the first PCA church in Georgetown.

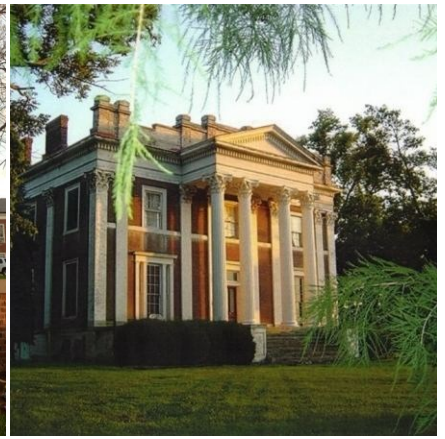

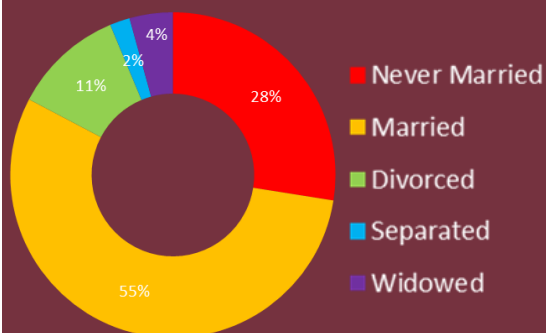
