

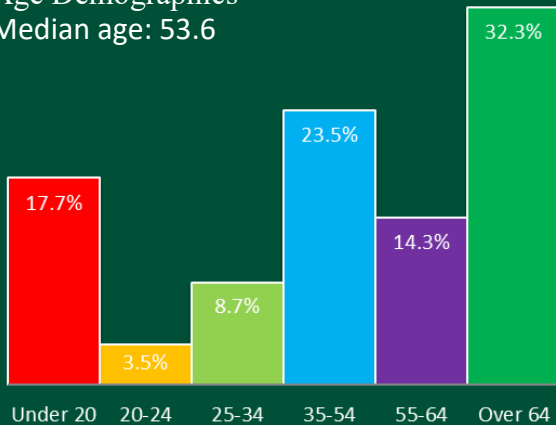

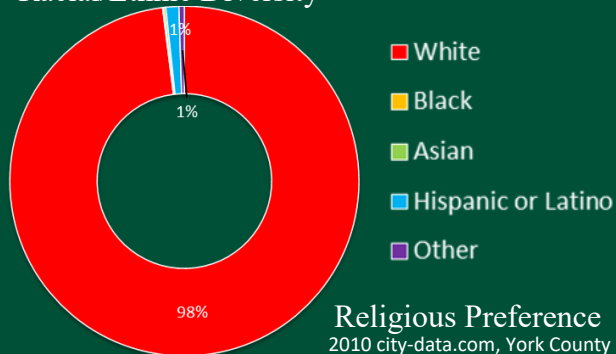

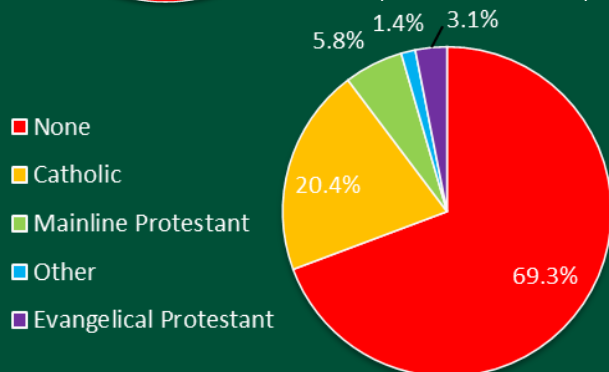


Racial/Ethnic Diversity

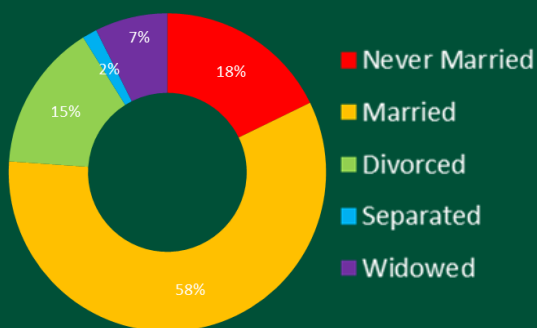
