



Age Demographics




Highlights

Approximately 20 miles west of Detroit and 25 miles east of Ann Arbor. Livonia has more than 1,389 acres of recreational open space in which there are 60 parks (36 developed and 24 undeveloped). White collar workers make up 70% of the workforce. There are more than 4,000 businesses in Livonia. Major local employers include: Ford Motor Company, Trinity Health, McLaren Performance Technologies, NYX Inc., Roush Enterprises, St. Mary Mercy Hospital, United Parcel Services (UPS), and Amazon.
