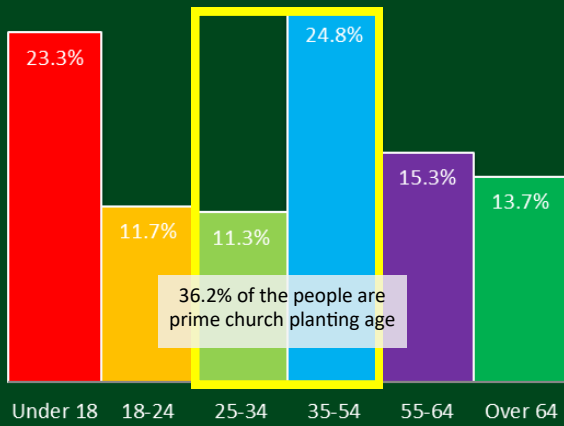

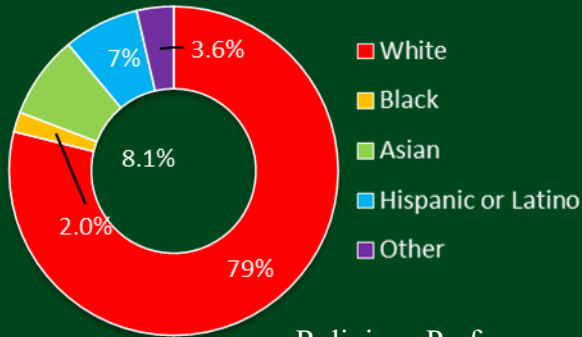

Age Demographics

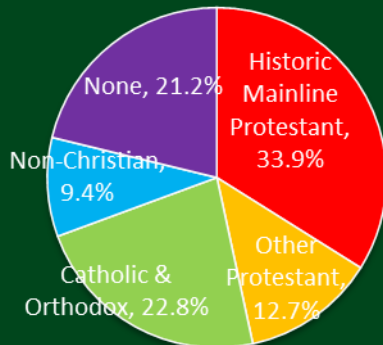

Racial/Ethnic Diversity



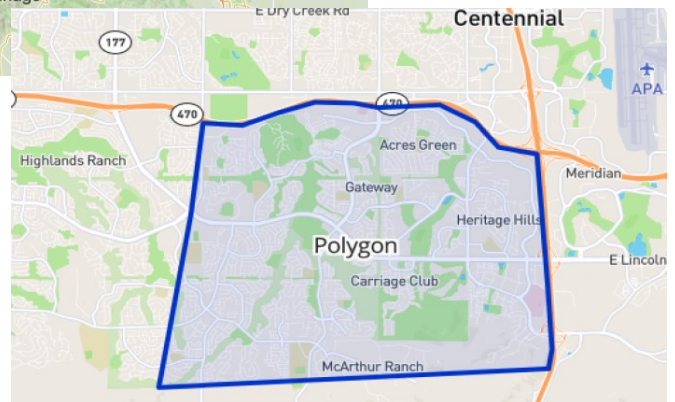
Religious Preference



Lone Tree Elevated, a comprehensive planning initiative that will guide the future growth and development of the City of Lone Tree, states that the city has “achieved remarkable milestones since its founding in 1995, and has solidified its position as a premier Colorado community.” The Western Church Planting Network (WCPN) is committed to seeing a PCA church planted in Lone Tree that will reach this growing community.

WCPN foresees a healthy and growing, self-sustaining and self-governing PCA church in Lone Tree characterized by vibrant Christ-centered worship, effective ministries of evangelism, mercy, and missions coupled with transformational fellowship and discipleship all to the glory of God. The hope is to see this church make disciples who will then help to spread the gospel, multiplying praise to God and planting churches throughout the region.

The WCPN’s vision is to plant 20 churches by the year 2025 (twenty churches in ten years). To date we have planted 13 churches and we have 2 new works in process. Each plant entails



shepherding a prospective planter through a church planting residency. This allows the candidate to experience the culture and realities of church planting without the pressure of organizing a church while also allowing time to discern whether this plant is a good match for both parties.

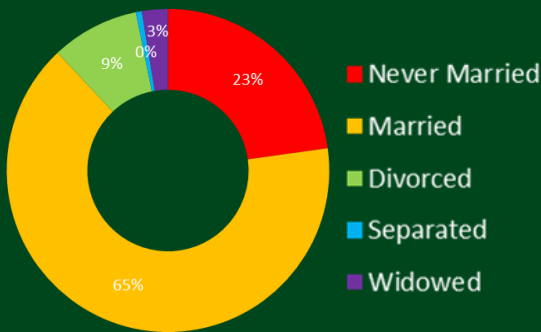
