According to Madison County data, the need for growth in the gospel is also great in this area. About 50% of the population identifies as having no religious affiliation.

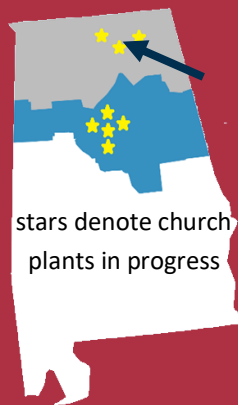
Providence Presbytery and the Alabama Church Planting

By the grace of God, this church plant will bring spiritual growth to this growing area.

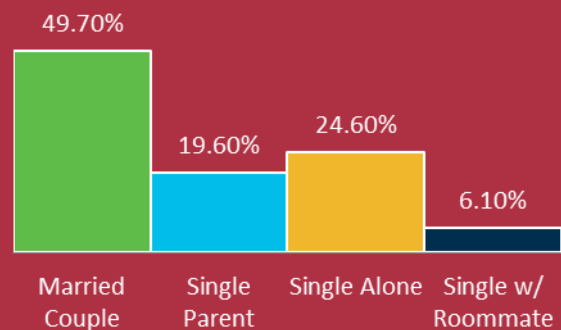

Household Type

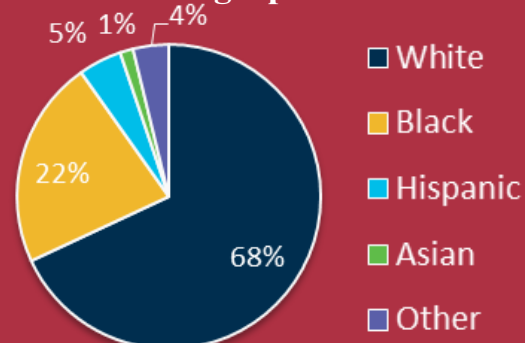

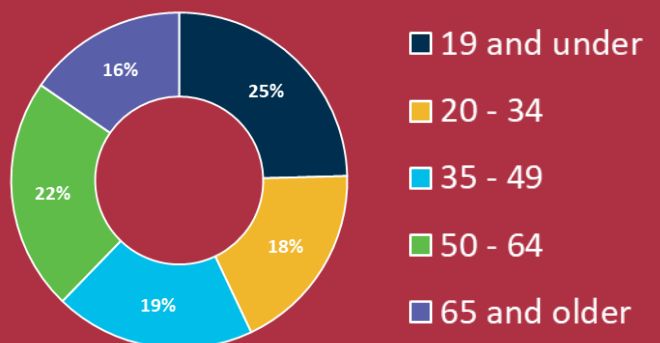

Local Highlights

Huntsville is home of the US Space & Rocket Center, NASA's Marshall Space Flight Center, and the United States Army Aviation & Missile Command at Redstone Arsenal.

Boasts three iconic historic districts: Twickenham, Old Town, & Five Points.

Site of University of Alabama in Huntsville, Strayer University, and Alabama A&M University.

112-acre botanical garden that includes the nation's largest open-air seasonal butterfly house.

Burritt on the Mountain is an open-air museum that sits on a high plateau near Monte Santo State Park. The grounds are filled with historic 19th century properties that have been brought from all over Alabama and placed here in the interests of preservation and education.

Monte Sano Nature Preserve is one of the largest urban land preserves in the United States. Only two miles from Downtown Huntsville, this 1100+ acre natural escape features over 22 miles of free public trails for hiking, biking, and outdoor recreation.
