



In a speech given in 2022, Mayor Jon Mitchell stated, "the New Bedford we aspire to build (is) a city that it is the cultural, economic and political center of a distinct region."

One of the things that makes this a distinct region is that it is constantly ranked as the most secular, post-Christian region

of the country. Bristol County's religious preference statistics highlight this with less than 8% of the people identifying as Protestant.

Highlights

Located on the Acushnet River about 60 miles south of Boston and about 30 miles southeast of Providence, Rhode Island

During the first half of the 19th century, New Bedford was one of the world's most important whaling ports.

Once the wealthiest city in the world per capita

In 2019 generated the highest annual value of any fishing port in the United States

Primary setting of Herman Melville's Moby-Dick

High school graduation increased from 58% to 88% in the last ten years

The Port of New Bedford generates over \$11 billion in annual economic activity, and supports nearly seven thousand jobs

In 2023 the Port will launch the American offshore wind industry with the Vineyard Wind project, the first of what is predicted to be more than \$24 billion worth of wind projects along the East Coast in the next decade


Imagine
