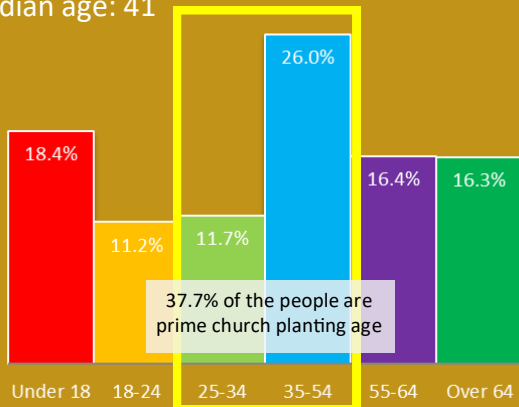

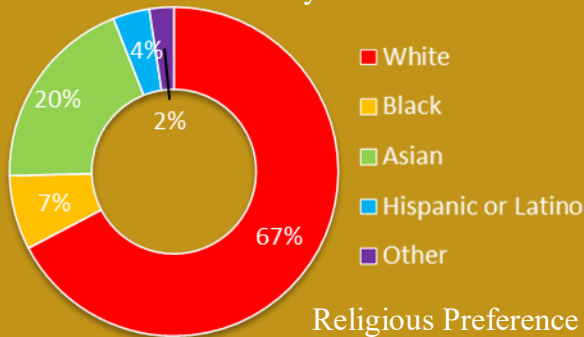

Age Demographics

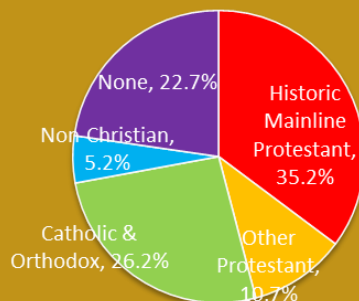

Novi, Michigan has invested in a citizen survey every other year since 2006 that revealed high rankings as a place to live, work, and raise children in the most recent survey. Novi also has a growing Asian Indian population. The most recent statistical reports show that of the 20% of the population that is Asian, about 5,000 people are Asian Indian.

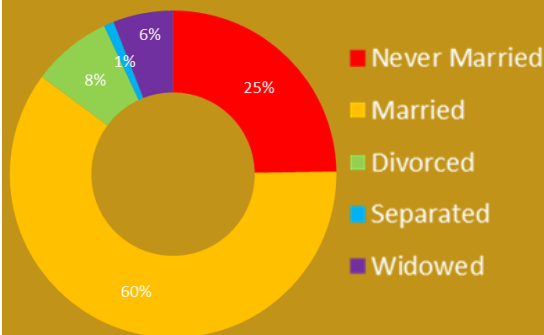
Highlights

Located about 30 miles northwest of Detroit and northeast of Ann Arbor. White collar workers make up 83% of the workforce.
