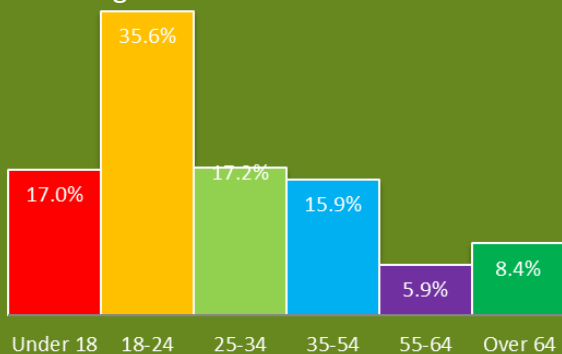

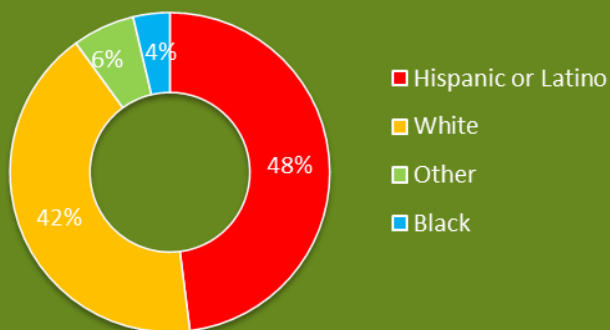

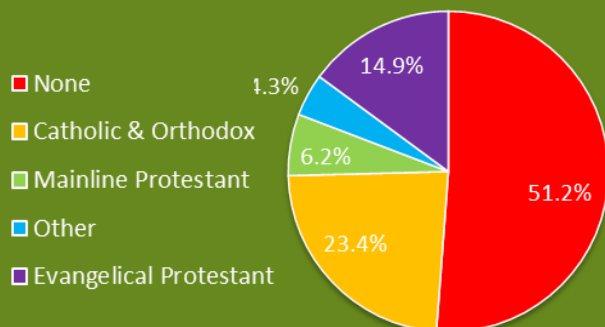


Racial/Ethnic Diversity

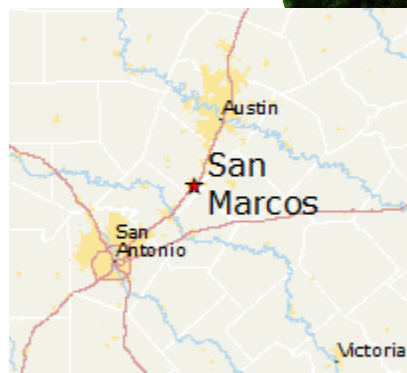


San Marcos, Texas is a college town and a great place to live for people who enjoy the arts and outdoor activities.

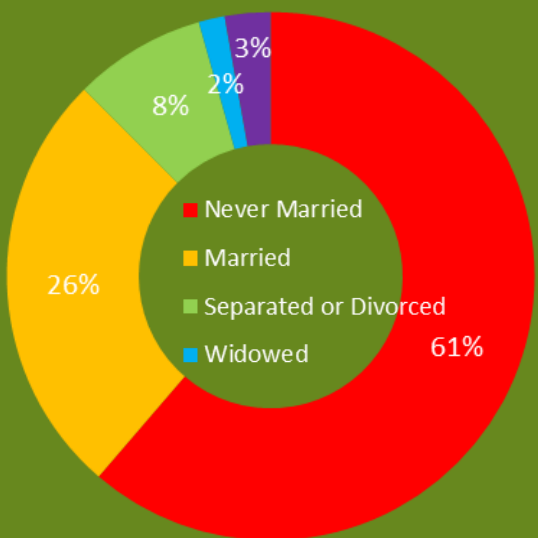
