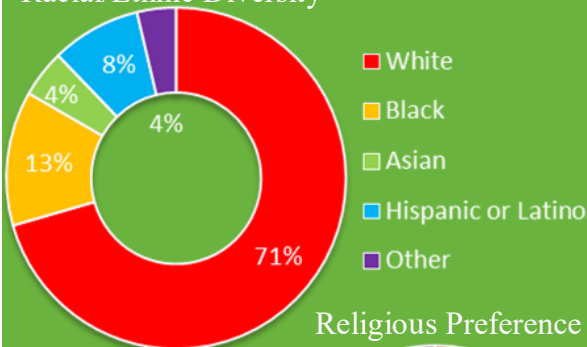

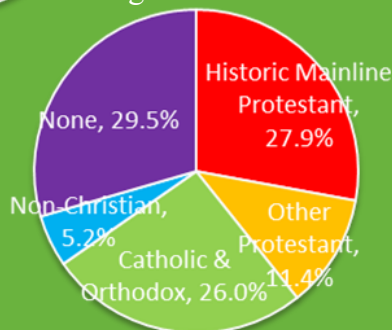

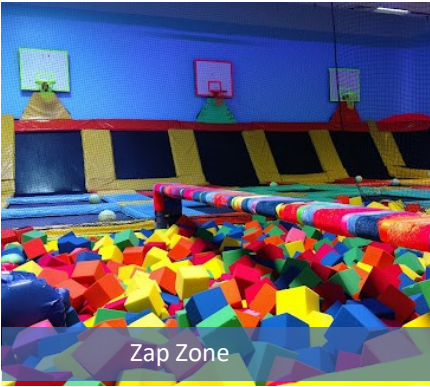


This plant would be closest to University Reformed's current location and would serve from the west side of Lansing to Grand Ledge.

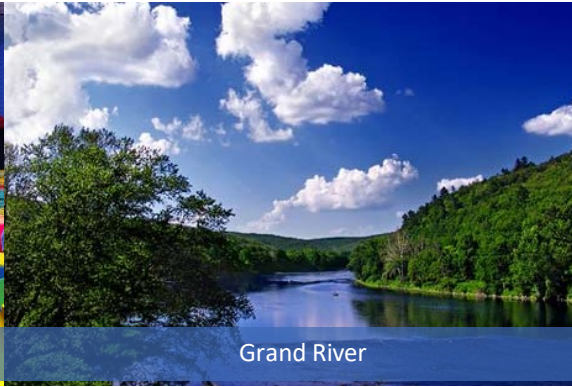

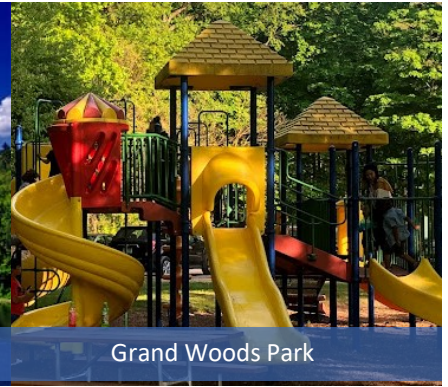
The hope is to see this church make disciples who will then help to spread the gospel, multiplying praise to God and planting churches throughout the region.

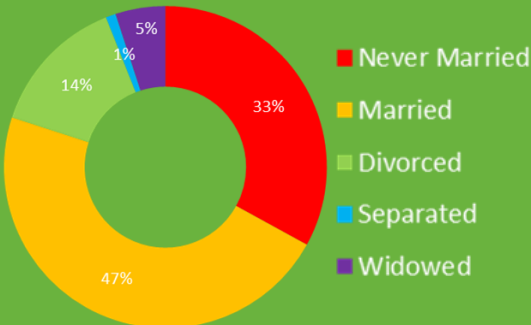
