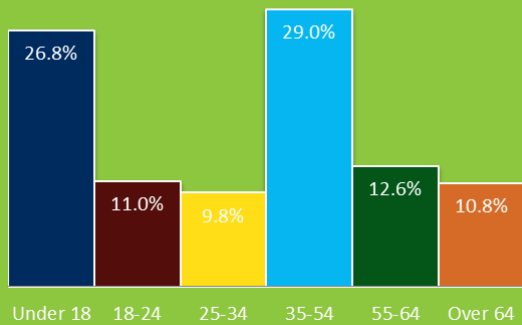

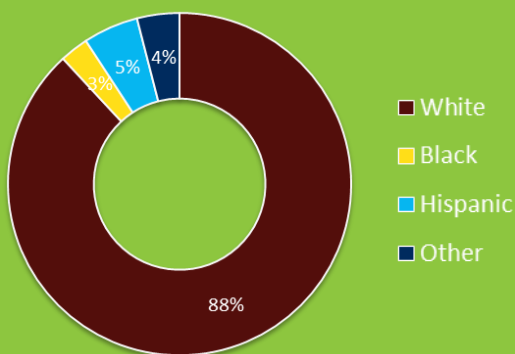

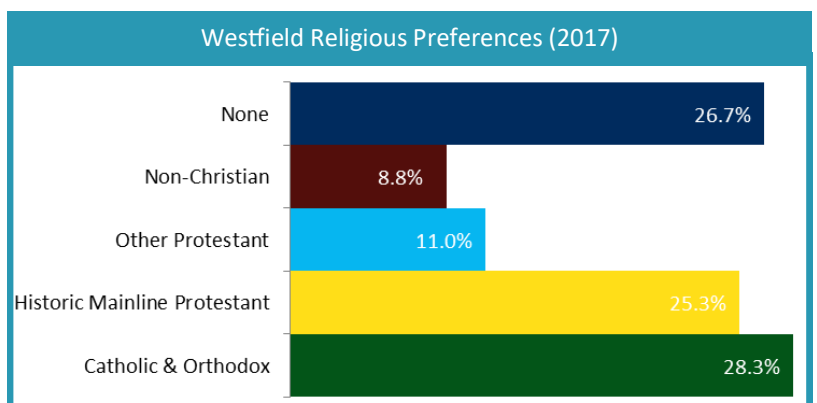
Significant growth is expected to continue for the next ten years as young, white-collar families are attracted to the good schools combined with low rates of crime and poverty.
