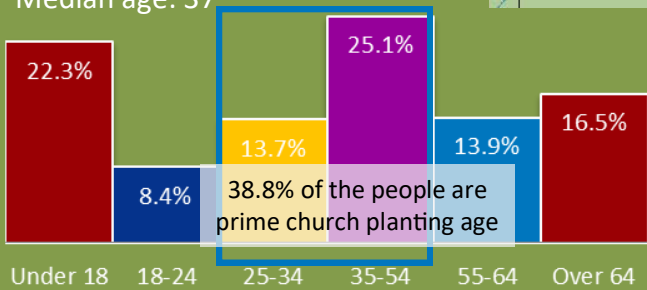

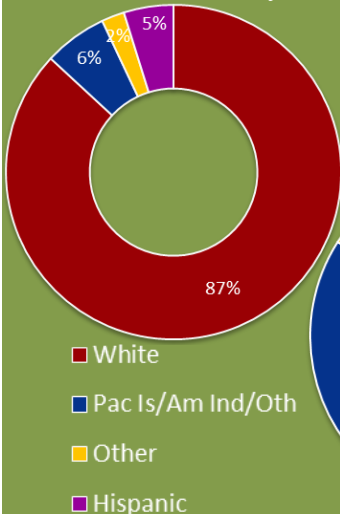


#### Households with Children

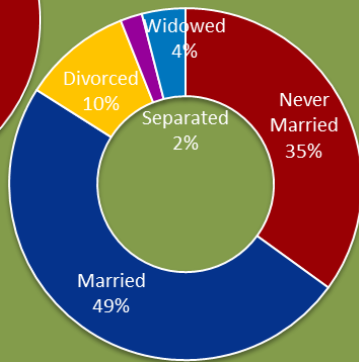
Married Couple	75%

With God’s help, the hope is to see this first PCA church in Williston make disciples who will then help to spread the gospel, multiplying praise to God and planting churches throughout the region.

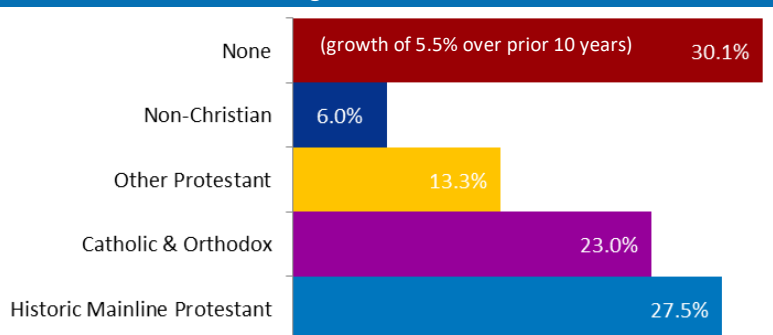
#### Race/Ethnicity
