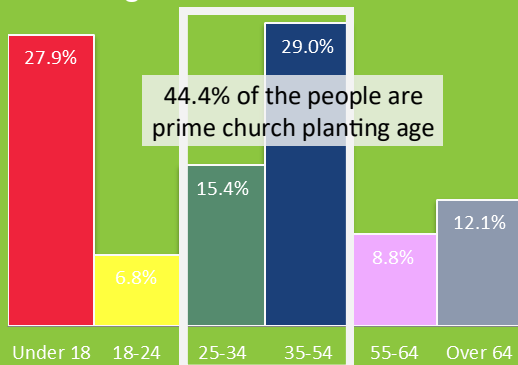

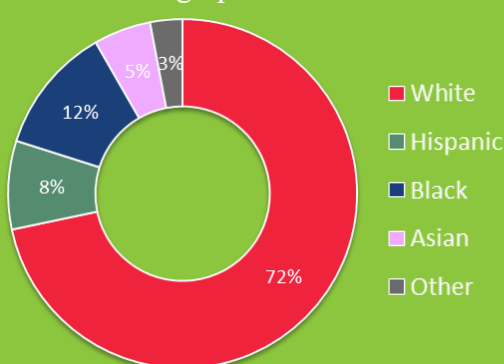

Racial Demographics



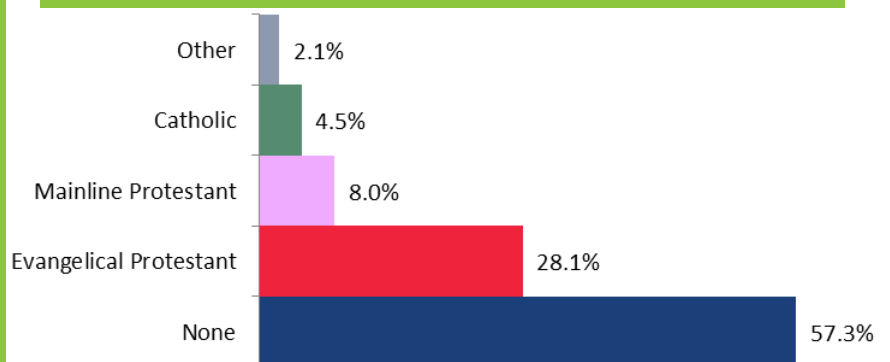
In 2017, Woodstock, Georgia rebranded and adopted the tagline, “Our Story Crafted By Your Dreams.” The city states, “The updated identity of Woodstock represents our continued progressive growth as a leading city dedicated to serving with professionalism.” Based on projections made by the Atlanta Regional Commission, Woodstock is expected to continue to grow quickly, adding over 13,000 people from year 2015 through the year 2040 for a total population of approximately 40,000 people. They have also noted that high-income households are the fastest growing in the city.



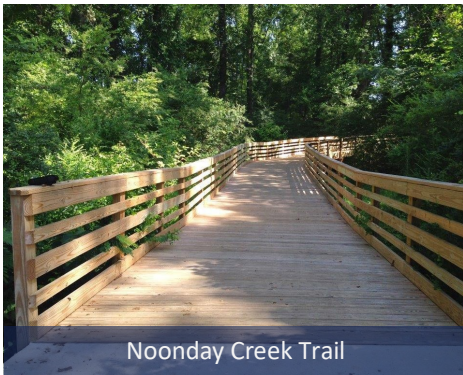
Growth and wealth may temporarily satisfy the dreams of the city’s people, but will not provide lasting joy. Woodstock Highlights

About 30 miles north of Atlanta.

Cherokee County School District received an "B" rating for 2019.

The city offers 5 parks & an amphitheater including water fountains, fishing platforms, athletic fields, walking & biking trails, playgrounds, and picnic grounds.

Part of the Greenprints Trail System, Rope Mill Park has become a regional "destination" park because of its 15-mile-long mountain bike trail system.

The outlet mall located closest to Atlanta is in Woodstock.

Named "one of the top 50 places to live" by Money Magazine in 2015.

According to the city's website, Woodstock is the fastest growing city in Cherokee County. With the growth rate of Woodstock at 70% over the past 10 years, the city has doubled in size.

65 universities are located within 50 miles of Woodstock.

The average commute time is 33 minutes.
