



The Central Indiana Presbytery is praying that those statistics will be changed by the work of God through their commitment to planting a PCA church in the area with the support of the Midwest Alliance.


Central Indiana Presbytery exists as a regional church to extend God's kingdom by strengthening existing churches, planting new churches, developing leaders, and caring for pastors.
