




New Kent County Statistics Mission Insite, 2024



- Located in the coastal plain, consisting mostly of flat land with some rolling hills; average elevation is 80 feet above sea level.
- Richmond International Airport is 10 minutes away, Newport News-Williamsburg International Airport is 30 minutes away


