

### **Area Highlights**

The Waccamaw Neck area is the fastest growing area of Georgetown County and has over 50% of the county's population.

Over 55% of the county's single-family detached units and over 75% of the multi-family and single-family attached units are located in this area.

The area is a seaside resort community located south of Myrtle Beach on the Grand Strand, and just north of the historic seaport City of Georgetown.



Historical sites in the area include
Brookgreen Gardens, Atalaya Castle,
Hobcaw Barony, and Pawleys Island.
The Waccamaw Neck has four public
schools-Waccamaw Elementary,
Intermediate, Middle, and High.
